The Port Huron Wastewater Treatment Plant returns about 9 million gallons of treated wastewater a day to the St. Clair River. Come learn about the treatment processes that clean the water, the discharge requirements, laboratory testing performed, and the biosolids program. Every citizen scientist and well-versed environmentalist needs to know how waste water is managed. Don't miss this free and family-friendly virtual tour!

Our tour guide, Patty Troy, is the lab manager of the Port Huron Waste Water Treatment Plant. Patty holds a BS in Environmental Health from Oakland University, and a "C" wastewater operator's license with the State of Michigan. Patty is also the U.S. Co-Chair of the Binational Public Advisory Council (BPAC) for the St. Clair River area of concern.
