Pollution Solutions is a hands-on classroom presentation that helps students relate the water cycle and pollution sources to their daily lives. Students "pollute" a model of a their community, watch the effects of a rainstorm and then discuss water quality problems and solutions. Connections are made between the health of the environment, land use, and human impacts on the land.
