This **free** program immerses 5th grade students in hands-on science inquiry and learning that support Next Generation Science Standards and STEM career exposure.

STUDENTS WILL

- Interact with wildlife biologists conducting sturgeon research on Lake Huron
- Collect, analyze and compare water samples from the river
- Use problem-solving skills to explore environmental issues
- Acquire knowledge about Michigan native and invasive species by gathering and analyzing data
- Develop an understanding of the connection between a healthy ecosystem and human impact on the environment
