Students are encouraged to submit drawings, sketches, poetry, timelines, diagrams, infographics, original songs, videos, or short stories to promote conservation of the Great Lakes' threatened Lake Sturgeon. Submissions are a student's ticket to participate in the Huron Lady Sturgeon Science Cruise.



Topic Ideas

- · Michigan Lake Sturgeon biology and habitat
- · Lake Sturgeon and native fish role & importance in the St. Clair River
- The history of Lake Sturgeon in the Great Lakes
- · Fish protection, clean water, and pollution prevention
- · Research and care of Lake Sturgeon in the Great Lakes

Submissions

- · Paper entries:
 - Use letter-sized paper (8.5"x 11"), and do not mount, frame, fold or roll submissions.
 - Include the following on the BACK of the entry: Student's name, Teacher's name, School
- · Digital entries:
 - Files must be saved as .jpg, .png, or .mp4 files. Video maximum length is 30 seconds.
 - Digital entries may be emailed or shared to Friends of the St. Clair River via Google Suite or Microsoft OneDrive.

· All entries:

- No misspelled words or depiction of copyrighted material.
- Keep it fresh! Submissions will be disqualified if ocean life or other sturgeon species are depicted.
- Submissions become property of the Friends of the St. Clair River.

Judging

- · Finalists will be chosen based on effectiveness and accuracy of the message, creativity and originality.
- Finalist's artwork will be on display at the Blue Water Sturgeon Festival on June 1, 2024. (SturgeonFestival.com)
- Judging will take place by a public vote using pocket change and online donations. Teachers will be notified of finalists in May.

Prizes

- Finalists' artwork may be featured on promotional materials or on social media. During Sturgeon Festival, the top three winners will be announced and receive a prize package as well as hand-release a baby Lake sturgeon into Lake Huron at Lighthouse Beach. Students do not need to be present to win prizes, but do need to be present to hand-release a baby sturgeon.
- · Homeschool students will be awarded two tickets for a Sturgeon Cruise if their entry is chosen as a finalist.
