Stream Scores

Friends of the St. Clair River's Stream Team volunteers monitor water quality in local streams. We use benthic macroinvertebrates (ie. aquatic insects) to assess the stream's health. Monitoring is performed every spring and fall.

Stream are assigned a score from "very poor" to "excellent" based on the amount and types of bugs found. Some macroinvertebrates are more sensitive to pollution than others, like water pennies and caddisflies, which give the stream an "excellent" score. The lower the number, the healthier the stream.

Winter Stoneflies


Every January, we hold a Winter Stonefly Search that is similar to our spring and fall monitoring events, except we only look for one type of macroinvertebrate. Winter stoneflies are a group of very sensitive aquatic insects that emerge from streams in the winter and do not tolerate poor water quality conditions.
